Show Parameters and Expectations

Curation of exhibition:

The exhibition's concept is to face the impossibility of portraying the city. By the time we make this exhibition the landscape has already changed.

This exhibition is to be a coexistence of ideas, images, thoughts, feelings. It's not only about being in Shenzhen, China or being Chinese or foreigner, it's about being together and not being together, about being different and being the same. We will be building its psychogeography.

It will be a constellation rather than just being a linear narrative, where it won't have an end or a beginning; it's a constant going back and forth through the photographs to allow them to create their own reality. It's just as about multiplicity as it is about openness.

The photographs have to be able to tell something and not only show. Each photographer has their own photographic language, the idea is that each one of the photographers will depict something different out of the city (or out of their experience) whether it's a portrait, a detail, a light, landscape, abstract, still life, an object, a colour. With this, the exhibition sets a moment of both recollection and of dialogue, reinforcing difference and heterogeneity.

- All artists who are selected to be in the show, must print their work using the Fotoshop Printing Studio in OCT-Loft.

Fees and Costs

- Show & Exhibition Fee:
 - 200 RMB (This is strictly for marketing/gallery materials and opening event supplies)
- Printing Process and Construction Fee(s):
 - \circ \geq 600 RMB (This is determined by size of work and number of pieces included in the show. See the attached document with the pricing.)





Submission and Curatorial Requirements

Submission Requirements:

- 3-5 high-resolution images of photographic work (in process or form) are to be submitted no later than Wednesday, February 28th to Brittan Aebischer (email: aebischerbd@gmail.com)
- Included in the email is a word document that includes the following information:
 - Artist Statement (5 sentences max)
 - Artist Bio (5 sentences max)
 - Artist Resume (includes applicable arts industry work and participated shows and exhibitions)
 - Title of each work submitted
 - Proposed printing size and photographic paper for each work submitted
- IF AN ARTIST SUBMITS WORK: THEY UNDERSTAND AND ACCEPT ALL SHOW PARAMETERS. THUS, COMMITTING TO THE SHOW'S TIMELINE, DEADLINES, AND FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS.

Curatorial Process:

- The Show's Curator, Catarina Braga, will be selecting work based on how pieces best fit together in relation to the exhibition concept.
- All work selected will be announced and all included artists will have 24 hours to re-submit high-resolution, print quality image files to Catarina Braga (email: <u>catarina.i.b@hotmail.com</u>)
- o All work is to be formally printed using Fotoshop Company services (As a condition of having the show in the gallery, all artists are required to use the printing services company Fotoshop as a pre-condition and gallery rental fee waiver. Fotoshop owns and operates the exhibition gallery to be used for this show and is not charging for the space)





Sales of All Exhibition Work:

- All work in the exhibition may be listed to sale by each individual artist. If an artist chooses not to sell their work, they must state so in the final submission.
- If the participating artists make a sale at any point while the work is being displayed in the FOTOSHOP Gallery, the sponsoring gallery shall take a commission of 20%.
- All buyers will strictly purchase the work through the FOTOSHOP Gallery and the artists will be paid directly through the gallery.
- Artists who privately sale their work that is currently being shown in the FOTOSHOP Gallery, will be required to pay the 20% commission of the sale to the gallery, even though the sale of the work was conducted indirectly.
- All artists will be solely responsible for the pricing of their work. However, both the Curator, Catarina Braga and Lead Producer, Brittan Aebischer have the right to negotiate with each artist the final pricing based on the group show as a whole.

- Wednesday, February 28th, 2018: Submission Deadline

- Thursday, March 8th, 2018: Selected Work Announcement
 - Selected photographers and work announcement
- Friday, March 9th, 2018
 - Final Digital Image files sent to Catarina Braga for final printing
- Friday, March 30th, 2018
 - o All work will be printed and ready
- Sunday, April 8th Tuesday, April 10th
 - Work is hung in gallery
- Friday, April 13th, 7-9 PM: Opening
 - Show Opening Event in the Fotoshop Gallery space in A5
 OCT-Loft (All artists required to attend)
